**North09 – a Camp for Christians – 27<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> August:** Following on from the success of North08, held at Col Beck Farm, Sexhow, North Yorkshire, the organisers have arranged another camp.

North09 is described as a camp for Christians within the *Newfrontiers* family of churches across the North and Scotland. It is a time of gathering for friendship, worship and teaching. *Newfrontiers* is a growing network, with over 200 churches in the UK. North09 will be servicing around 48 of those churches. *A leaflet on the notice board gives further details of the programme of activities for people who may interested in this event.*

**Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup>, June** there will be a walk and picnic – after the service – of about 4 miles and starting from the Danby Moors Centre at around 11.30am, after allowing for the normal coffee break in the church hall and the 20 minute drive to Danby.
